

## In a Bathroom/Toilet:

- When you use a Japanese-style bathroom/toilet, squat over the toilet bowl, facing its hemispherical hood.
- Use the toilet paper provided in the bathroom/toilet and flush it down the toilet bowl.



## At a Public Bath

- Put your clothes in a basket or a locker provided in the changing room after taking them off.
- Wash your body before getting into the bathtub.
- Rinse off soap and shampoo before getting into the bathtub.
- Do not get into the bathtub with a towel or underwear.
- Do not put a soap, a towel, etc. into the bathtub. Do not pull out the drain plug.



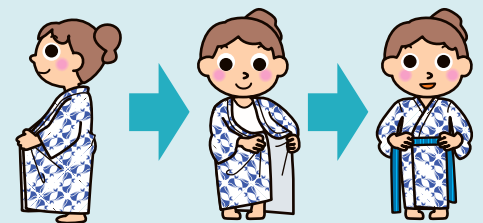
## At a Restaurant and the Like:

- Do not cut in line.
- Do not open the packages of food, etc. before making a purchase.
- Do not throw away leftovers and garbage on the floor.
- Do not bring/take food and drinks to the restaurant/home.



## How to Wear a Yukata:

- Put your arms through the sleeves of a yukata.
- Wrap the left side of the yukata over the right side.
- Wrap the sash around your body to tie it.
- Yukatas are available for rent during your stay.



## Others

- Do not take any equipment home with you.
- Be sure to smoke only in the smoking areas.
- Do not speak loudly when you walk along a corridor or eat at a restaurant.
- Please do not wear shoes, slippers, etc. when you walk on a tatami floor.
